Coaches Code of Conduct

I will:

1. Provide quality instruction in the fundamentals of the game of soccer.
2. Nurture a desire and enjoyment toward the game
3. Focus on building individual skills, tactics and teamwork
4. Teach strong character, work ethic, teamwork, and sportsmanship: Lead by example.
5. Create a safe and fun environment that is enjoyable for all involved including players, parents and coach.

6. Demonstrate leadership to the best of my ability
7. Strive to be organized in advance of all events
8. Be prepared with a lesson plan or goals to accomplish at each practice
9. Communicate event time & location information to team in a timely manner
10. Check email and voice mail routinely for updates & schedule changes

11. Notify the Age Group Coordinator (AGC) in writing of all player injuries that occur during club sanctioned team events
12. Provide the families of injured players with the necessary forms for reporting a medical injury that occurs during a sanctioned team event
13. Report all unresolved conflicts that occur between your team and our opponents, and/or the referee staff, in writing within 48 hours of the event. Be sure to include objective and unemotional details.
14. Further my understanding of the rules of the game of soccer
15. Utilize all available resources to improve ability to instruct youth soccer

16. Not allow players to participate in any field activity without proper safety equipment
17. Not allow unregistered players to participate in any team activities
18. Ensure there is a registered adult with the team at all times or cancel the event
19. Not allow unregistered family members to participate in routine team field activities
20. Never leave a player unsupervised, the coach is always the last to leave.

21. Inspect and restock the first aid kit as needed
22. Review and verify the information contained in the medical release form (emergency #'s, allergies, special needs) with the parents of every player
23. Have a copy of every players medical release form on hand at every event
24. Send the medical release form with the player to the emergency room
25. Ensure the player is NOT transported to the hospital alone. If a parent is not on site, a registered team staff or designated responsible adult must stay with the player until such time as the parents arrive.

26. Agree to follow the OYSA Coaches Code of Conduct guidelines
27. Agree to follow the OYSA Credo for Sportsmanship
28. Agree to follow the WSSC Credo for Sportsmanship
29. Review the WSSC Parent Code of Conduct with parents of every player and obtain their signature prior to allowing the player to participate in games
30. Provide constructive feedback to the AGC and Head Coach on how to improve the organization
